Mr. Vroom was first licensed as an All-Breed Handler in 1966 and has had over 750 Best In Shows and over 4,000 Group Firsts. He has handled four Quaker Oats winners and seven Westminster Kennel Club Group Winners. He has handled three dogs to Top Dog All-Breeds. He was voted Fido Dog Handler of the Year and Kennel Review Dog Handler of the Year two times each.

HOUN'HOUSE is a first class, climate controlled facility located a little west of the North Dallas Tollway in Carrollton, Texas.

From Dallas North Tollway exit Parker Road, proceed west on Parker approximately two miles. As soon as you cross the railroad tracks, turn right at first street (Dozier Road). Proceed one half block and you are there. As soon as you cross the RR, look for a sign on the right that will say "HOUNHOUSE NEXT RIGHT".

From I-35E take 121 Business to FM 544, turn right, cross Josey, cross Plano Parkway (blinking red light), take left at HOUN'HOUSE sign (where road curves to the right).

Registration fees include continental breakfast and lunch both days. Classes will be held from 9:00 AM until 4:00 – 5:00 PM both days.

The purpose of this Seminar is to teach **you** how to handle a dog in the show ring. It is **not** a training class for the dog. Therefore it is important that the dog be at least one (1) year old and well trained. A Participant may alternate between two (2) dogs.

Mr. Vroom will work alternately with each class for about an hour at a time during which time the other class will practice in another ring.

Each participant should wear appropriate rubber soled shoes, have a show lead and bring something upon which to take notes. Bring your own crate and a covering, if needed.

BEGINNERS: LIMITED TO TWENTY (20) PARTICIPANTS: Participants must be 10 years of age or older. Dog should be at least one (1) year old.

(An older and better trained dog will be to your advantage)

ADVANCED: LIMITED TO TWENTY (20) PARTICIPANTS: Participants should have handled for five (5) years and/or handled two (2) dogs to their Championship. Participants should not have to think about their every move. Dog should be at least one (1) year old.

OBSERVER: LIMITED TO FORTY (40) PARTICIPANTS
